This group meets on the 2nd Tuesday of each month. Normally there are three tables so six couples are required for play. We play four boards with each of five couples. The hosting is rotated among the regulars and the hosts provide snacks and refreshments (wine, soft drinks, coffee, dessert). The festivities begin at 7:00 pm and are generally concluded around 10:15 (although the socializing may go later into the evening). Each couple contributes \$2 and three couples will take money home.

Eventually, attrition will occur and a sub couple will be asked to join as regulars. (Subs do not have to host.) You do not have to be a married couple; some of our couples are just good friends.
