This is a group of six couples who play "party bridge" instead of duplicate. Starting on the first Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm, we play four hands against each of five other couples.

We score the total points on each hand using "Chicago" scoring. The winners are based on total points for the evening. We play for \$2/couple and three couples take home winnings. The role of host rotates among the regulars. The host provides wine and soft drinks, snacks, and dessert at the end of the evening. It tends to be very social but that doesn't mean it's not competitive.
